Information Technology Projects [LFB Paper #636]

Motion:

Move to adopt Alternatives A1 and B2. Alternative A1 would approve the Governor's recommendation to provide \$2,500,000 PR in 2019-20 and \$1,500,000 PR in 2020-21 in one-time funding for information technology improvement projects to replace the trades credentialing system. Alternative B2 would provide \$495,000 PR in 2019-20 and \$530,000 PR in 2020-21 as one-time funding instead of ongoing funding for information technology improvement projects.

In addition, direct the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) to transfer \$5,000,000 in 2019-20 from the balance of the Division of Industry Services program revenue general operations appropriation [s. 20.165 (2)(j)] to the general fund.

Note:

The motion would provide the Governor's recommended amount for information technology projects, but would provide the ongoing funding as one-time.

Under the bill as introduced, the Division of Industry Services general operations program revenue appropriation for regulation of building trades professions would have an estimated June 30, 2021, balance of \$15,272,700. The motion would reduce the balance by \$5,000,000, by transferring that amount to the general fund in 2019-20.
