1 **AN ACT to amend** 66.0602 (2m) (b) 1. of the statutes; **relating to:** reduction of  
2 local levy limit by amount of certain fee revenue.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Generally, under current law, local levy limits are applied to the property tax levies that are imposed by political subdivisions in December of each year. Current law prohibits a political subdivision from increasing its levy by a percentage that exceeds its "valuation factor," which is defined as the greater of either 0 percent or the percentage change in the political subdivision's equalized value due to new construction, less improvements removed.

Also under current law, a political subdivision must reduce its allowable levy by the estimated amount of any revenue from fees or payments in lieu of taxes if the revenue is received for providing certain "covered services" that were funded with property tax revenues in calendar year 2013. The "covered services" are certain garbage collection, fire protection, snow plowing, street sweeping, and storm water management. This bill eliminates storm water management from the list of "covered services" under this levy limit adjustment.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

**SECTION 1.** 66.0602 (2m) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
