Lis and Zach,

Pursuant to yesterday's JFC executive session, I have some drafting requests for you. I've attached the approved motion (#144). Below follows the drafting request or each part of the motion:

1. *Stewardship Extension*. Please increase the bonding authority under s. 20.866(2)(ta) by \$42,600,000 to \$1,088,850,000. We are using LRBb0073/P1 as
3. *Law Enforcement Radios*. Please create 3 biennial appropriations under s. 20.370(3): one from the general fund, one from the environmental fund and one from the conservation fund.
7. *Automatic Renewal for . . . Licenses*. Section 348 of the Governor's bill was approved.
8. *Off-Highway Motorcycles*. Please incorporate LRB 2971/P2 (attached) as a budget amendment.
11. *Chronic Wasting Disease Research*. Please draft language to require DNR to expend \$100,000 from 20.370(1)(hx) as one-time funding to research genetic resistance to chronic wasting disease in farmed deer. Require the research be conducted at a double-fenced deer farm in southern Wisconsin where CWD was detected in a farm-raised deer in spring of 2018.
12. *State Trail Repairs*. Please incorporate LRB 3282/P2 (attached as 400Trail LRB.pdf) as a budget amendment.
13. *Tribal Gaming Revenues for Snowmobile Enforcement*. The Governor's request was not approved. Please delete the following sections from the bill:
 - a. section 177 (which deletes s. 20.370(3)(ak)),
 - b. section 178 (which allows 20.370(3)(ma) to be spent on snowmobile enforcement),
 - c. section 280 (which repeals s. 20.505(8)(hm)12.),
 - d. section 2022 (which amends the enforcement introduction to reflect the chapter 20 changes),
 - e. section 2023 (which amends the enforcement introduction to reflect the chapter 20 changes),
 - f. and section 2024 (which amends the enforcement introduction to reflect the chapter 20 changes).

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 56**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1114, line 13: after that line insert:

3 “(3) CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE RESEARCH. The department of natural resources
4 shall make a one-time expenditure of \$100,000 from the appropriation account
5 under s. 20.370 (1) (hx) to fund research into genetic resistance to chronic wasting
6 disease in farm-raised deer. The department shall conduct the research at a
7 double-fenced deer farm in the southern part of the state where chronic wasting
8 disease was detected in a farm-raised deer in the spring of 2018.”
