Motion:

Move to adopt the following provisions:

**Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection**

1. *Dairy Assistance Programs (Paper #135)*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to: (a) provide \$200,000 GPR in 2019-20 for the Wisconsin Initiative for Dairy Exports; (b) increase funding for dairy processor grants by \$200,000 GPR annually; (c) specify that DATCP's dairy promotion duties shall include providing grants to local organizations that coordinate grazing, and expand the dairy promotion appropriation to allow the provision of grazing grants; and (d) provide \$52,600 GPR in 2019-20 and \$70,100 GPR in 2020-21 and 1.0 organic and grazing specialist.

2. *Industrial Hemp Program (Paper #136)*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to provide 3.0 GPR two-year project positions with \$162,400 GPR in 2019-20 and \$216,500 GPR in 2020-21, as well as one-time funding of \$300,000 GPR in 2019-20 for regulation of industrial hemp.

3. *Farm-to-School Grants and Position (Paper #137)*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to provide DATCP \$200,000 GPR annually for farm-to-school grants and provide the Department of Public Instruction 1.0 GPR position with \$48,000 GPR in 2019-20 and \$63,500 GPR in 2020-21.

4. *Farmer Mental Health (Paper #138)*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to provide \$100,000 GPR each year to DATCP for farmer mental health assistance.

5. *Buy Local, Buy Wisconsin Grants (Paper #139)*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to provide an additional \$100,000 GPR each year for Buy Local, Buy Wisconsin grants.

6. *Laboratory Equipment and Service Charges (Paper #140)*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to provide an additional \$250,000 PR in 2019-20 and \$300,000 GPR in 2020-21 for laboratory services.

7. *Food, Lodging and Recreation Continuing Appropriation Authority (Paper #141)*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to convert the appropriation for food, lodging and recreational

16. *Dairy Innovation Hub*. Provide \$7,900,000 GPR in 2019-20 and in 2020-21 in a new appropriation to fund the Dairy Innovation Hub (DIH). Require the Board of Regents to create a UW Dairy Innovation Hub funded from this appropriation. Require that the DIH include operations at the UW-Madison, UW-Platteville, and the UW-River Falls. Specify that the DIH include disciplines in four separate sectors to accomplish all of the following objectives: (a) ensure animal health and welfare; (b) enrich human health and nutrition; (c) steward land and water resources; and (d) grow farm businesses and communities.

Require the Board to allocate 52% of the funding to do all of the following in connection with the DIH at the UW-Madison: (a) create positions which may include faculty positions, post-doctoral research fellowship positions, graduate student fellowship positions, grant writer staff positions, or any combination of these positions; (b) create a DIH administrator position; (c) establish and operate an advanced dairy management academy to provide training and facilitate technology transfer; and (d) provide support for research facilities and infrastructure, including research-related farms, laboratories, and equipment.

Require the Board to allocate 24% of the funding to do all of the following in connection with the DIH at the UW-Platteville: (a) create positions which may include faculty positions, post-doctoral research fellowship positions, graduate student fellowship positions, grant writer staff positions, building staff positions, or any combination of these positions, and, upon request of the Chancellor, provide research fellowships for existing faculty; and (b) provide support for research facilities and infrastructure, including research-related farms, laboratories, and equipment.

Require the Board to allocate 24% of the funding to do all of the following in connection with the DIH at the UW-River Falls: (a) create positions which may include faculty positions, post-doctoral research fellowship positions, graduate student fellowship positions, grant writer staff positions, building staff positions, or any combination of these positions, and, upon request of the Chancellor, provide research fellowships for existing faculty; and (b) provide support for research facilities and infrastructure, including research-related farms, laboratories, and equipment.

Require the Board of Regents by July 1, 2021, and annually thereafter, to report to the Legislature for distribution to the appropriate standing committees all of the following: (a) an identification of all positions created under this provision and whether the position is filled or vacant; (b) for each filled position, a description of the accomplishments associated with that position, both since the position was created and during the immediately preceding year; (c) a description of the major accomplishments of the DIH, both since its inception and during the immediately preceding year.

Specify that the Board of Regents ensure that the funding and positions provided under this motion reflect a bona fide increase in funding for the specified purposes and that no other funding provided to the Board is reduced as a result of, or reduced in a way that offsets, the additional funding for the DIH. Authorize the Board to pay from the UW System's GPR general program operations appropriation the cost of employer contributions for employee fringe benefits under Chapter 40 of the

statutes. (This would incorporate 2019 Assembly Bill 207/Senate Bill 186.)

- 1 **AN ACT to create** 20.285 (1) (er) and 36.25 (59) of the statutes; **relating to:**  
2 creating and funding a University of Wisconsin Dairy Innovation Hub and  
3 making an appropriation.

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***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System to create a UW Dairy Innovation Hub. The bill provides \$7,900,000 each year to the UW System to fund the requirements under the bill. The Dairy Innovation Hub must include operations at UW-Madison, UW-Platteville, and UW-River Falls. The Dairy Innovation Hub must also include disciplines in four separate sectors to accomplish the following objectives: ensure animal health and welfare; enrich human health and nutrition; steward land and water resources; and grow farm businesses and communities. The Board of Regents must allocate funding under the bill as follows: 52 percent to create positions, establish and operate an advanced dairy management academy, and provide support for research facilities and infrastructure at UW-Madison; 24 percent to create positions and provide support for research facilities and infrastructure at UW-Platteville; and 24 percent to create positions and provide support for research facilities and infrastructure at UW-River Falls. The Board of Regents must annually submit a report to the legislature regarding the Dairy Innovation Hub.
