**SENATE AMENDMENT 10,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 56**

June 26, 2019 - Offered by Senator LARSON.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly amendment  
2           1, as follows:

3           **1.** Page 376, line 7: after that line insert:

4           “**SECTION 790r.** 66.0602 (3) (e) 10. of the statutes is created to read:

5           66.0602 (3) (e) 10. The amount that a political subdivision levies in that year  
6           for purposes related to the replacement of lead pipe water service lines owned by the  
7           political subdivision.”.

8           **2.** Page 424, line 10: after that line insert:

9           “**SECTION 1742c.** 121.91 (4) (om) of the statutes is created to read:

10           121.91 (4) (om) 1. If a school board adopts a resolution to do so, the limit  
11           otherwise applicable to a school district under sub. (2m) in any school year is  
12           increased by the amount spent by the school district in that school year on a project,  
13           including the payment of debt service on a bond or note issued, or a state trust fund

1 loan obtained, to finance the project, to remediate lead contamination in water used  
2 for drinking or food preparation in the school district. In this subdivision, the  
3 amount spent by the school district includes costs incurred by the school district to  
4 test for the presence of lead in water used for drinking or food preparation in school  
5 buildings in the school district, to install a lead filtration device on a water fountain  
6 or tap used to provide water used for drinking or food preparation, to provide potable  
7 water to affected school buildings during remediation, and, if necessary, to replace  
8 drinking fountains, pipes, solders, pipe fittings, and plumbing fixtures to and within  
9 affected school buildings in the school district. The term of a bond or note issued or  
10 state trust fund loan obtained to finance a project under this subdivision may not  
11 exceed 20 years. If a school board issues a bond or note or obtains a state trust fund  
12 loan to finance a project described in this subdivision, a resolution adopted by a  
13 school board under this subdivision is valid for each school year in which the school  
14 board pays debt service on the bond, note, or state trust fund loan.

15 2. Any additional revenue received by a school district under this paragraph  
16 shall not be included in the base for determining the school district's limit under sub.  
17 (2m) for the following school year.”.

18 **3.** Page 505, line 25: after that line insert:

19 “(4p) LEVY LIMIT LEAD WATER LINE REPLACEMENT. The treatment of s. 66.0602 (3)  
20 (e) 10. first applies to a levy that is imposed in December 2019.”.
