 - **3.** Page 13, line 9: delete lines 9 to 13 and substitute "construct, modify, maintain, and operate conduit, cable, and related appurtenances under a right-of-way. Such small wireless facilities, conduit, cable, and appurtenances, and activities related to their installation and maintenance, may not obstruct or hinder travel, drainage, maintenance,".
 - **4.** Page 13, line 20: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with page 14, line 15, and substitute:
 - "2. With regard to the rights of a wireless provider to construct small wireless facilities or modify conduit, cable, and related appurtenances as described in subd.

 1., a political subdivision may require a location other than the location proposed by
