Eric,

After several discussions following our public hearing on SB 320, we would like to have a p draft of a simple amendment that accomplishes the following:

1. Explicitly permit the insurer to notify the insured via electronic means to satisfy the requirements under the bill.
2. Explicitly permit proof of an electronic payment as sufficient to satisfy the requirements under the bill.
3. Strike language referencing titles issued in another state on page 2, line 12. WisDOT has indicated they cannot/should not alter titles issued in another state.
4. Insert 3 month effective date.

While the changes dealing with electronic notification and proof may not strictly be necessary under our statutes, the insurance industry recommended the explicit language in response to issues encountered in other states. WisDOT agreed with their assessment and believes it would be helpful for them to ensure that language was clarified.

I have provided their suggested language below, but as always feel free to draft as you see fit.

Page 2. Line 10: After payment of claim insert:

, or by certified mail, or by electronic means such as e-mail or by posting on an electronic network or site accessible via the Internet, mobile application, computer, mobile device, tablet or any other electronic device .

Page 2, Line 10 delete language beginning with "If" and ending with line 11 "department,"

Page 2, Line 12 delete sentence beginning with : "If" and ending on line 14 "state."

Page 2. Line 19: After "vehicle." insert:

An electronic image of a screen or other representation showing payment of the claim via electronic funds transfer or some other electronic means shall constitute sufficient evidence of payment.

Page 3. Line 6 after "mail." insert:

or by electronic means such as e-mail or by posting on an electronic network or site accessible via the Internet, mobile application, computer, mobile device, tablet or any other electronic device .

Page 3, line 7 Insert effective date of 3 months after publication.

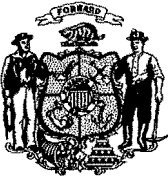
