This amendment removes the appropriation increases in AB 119 because funding equal to those increases is being provided in the biennial budget bill, as described below.

The Joint Committee on Finance passed Motion 41 on May 14, 2019. Under that motion, \$1,000,000—the total amount of appropriation increases proposed in AB 119—is being set aside in the 2019-21 biennial budget in one of JCF's supplemental appropriations in order to fund, consistent with AB 119, grants related to homeless shelters awarded by the Department of Administration under s. 16.308 (2) (a).

Under s. 13.101 (3) (a) 1., JCF may supplement an agency's appropriation only if JCF finds that an emergency exists. This amendment, in addition to removing the appropriation increases, exempts from that emergency requirement any request of DOA in the 2019-21 fiscal biennium for JCF to supplement DOA's appropriation under s. 20.505 (7) (fm) for the purpose of providing the grants authorized under s. 16.308 (2) (a).

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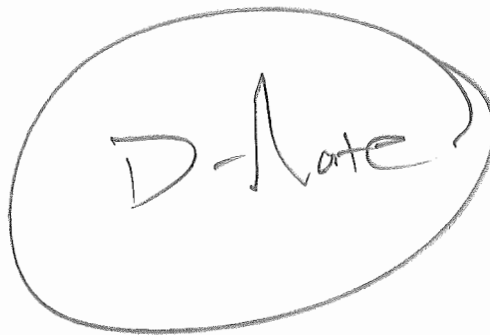
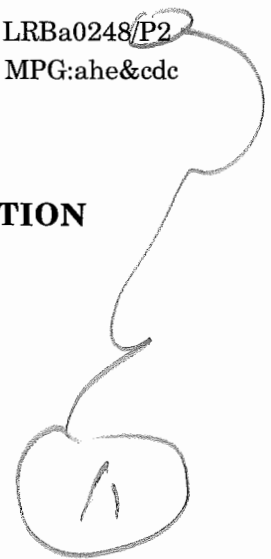
