3 assembly amendment 1, delete that line and substitute:

4 “or (c) nor may the the state superintendent appoint a member to the advisory  
5 committee under sub. (4) (d) if any of the following apply to the individual:”

6 **2.** Page 4, line 7: before that line insert:

7 “(c) Notwithstanding par. (b), the state superintendent may appoint an  
8 individual to the advisory committee under sub. (4) (d) if the disqualifying conduct  
9 under par. (c) applies to the individual solely because of the individual’s employment  
10 at the department of public instruction.”

11 **3.** Page 5, line 1: delete “8” and substitute “5”.

1           **4.** Page 5, line 6: after “public instruction.”, delete the material inserted by  
2 assembly amendment I.

3           **5.** Page 5, line 7: delete “Eight” and substitute “Five”.

4           **6.** Page 5, line 9: delete “Eight” and substitute “Five”.

5           **7.** Page 5, line 10: after that line insert:

6           “4. One member who represents the Wisconsin Association of School Boards.

7           5. One member who represents the Wisconsin Association of School District  
8 Administrators.

9           6. One member who represents the Wisconsin Council of Administrators of  
10 Special Services.

11           7. One member who represents the largest statewide organization  
12 representing parents of pupils.

13           8. One member who represents the largest statewide labor organization  
14 representing teachers and is a classroom teacher at an elementary school.

15           9. One member who is a neuropsychologist and has extensive experience in  
16 diagnosing dyslexia in children between the ages of ~~four~~<sup>4</sup> and ~~eighteen~~<sup>18</sup>.”
