*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 **SECTION 1.** DCF 50.09 (1) (b) 1. and 2. of the administrative code are amended  
3 to read:

4 DCF 50.09 (1) (b) 1. The child is ~~10~~ 7 years of age or older if age is the only factor  
5 in determining eligibility.

6 2. The child is a member of a sibling group of ~~3~~ 2 or more children that must  
7 be placed together.

8 **SECTION 1g. Nonstatutory provisions.**

9 (1) The department of children and families may submit a request under s.  
10 13.101 (4) to the joint committee on finance to transfer moneys from another
