#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Administration administers a service award program, which provides monetary length-of-service awards to volunteer fire fighters, first responders, and volunteer emergency medical technicians. Under the program, DOA pays a state match of up to \$390 per service award per fiscal year based on amounts contributed by municipalities. The appropriation for the state match paid by DOA is currently capped at \$2,500,000 per fiscal year.

This bill increases that amount to \$2,805,700 in fiscal year 2019–20 and \$2,900,000 in fiscal year 2020–21 and subsequent fiscal years.
