1 AN ACT *to renumber and amend* 20.505 (4) (er); and *to create* 20.505 (4) (er)
2 1. and 2. of the statutes; **relating to:** funding for service award payments and
3 making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Administration administers a service award program, which provides monetary length-of-service awards to volunteer fire fighters, first responders, and volunteer emergency medical technicians. Under the program, DOA pays a state match of up to \$390 per service award per fiscal year based on amounts contributed by municipalities. The appropriation for the state match paid by DOA is currently capped at \$2,500,000 per fiscal year.

This bill increases that amount to \$2,805,700 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$2,900,000 in fiscal year 2020-21 and subsequent fiscal years.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
