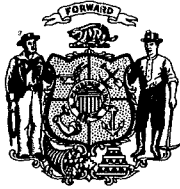
Hi Elisabeth,

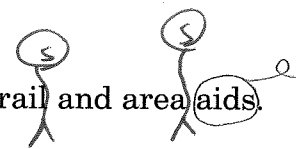
