



Melinda,

We are going to further refine Section 6 of SB 369 in the amendment. We are going to adjust the time limit for payment based on if it is a "small" or "large" project (See below). Definitions of "large" and "small" projects are found here: <a href="https://www.law.cornell.edu/cfr/text/44/206.203">https://www.law.cornell.edu/cfr/text/44/206.203</a>. I'll take it as a P2 please.

Staci Duros found and sent me the reference: "It looks like thresholds are adjusted annually or as needed to account for changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI). The Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 5121-5207, as amended by the Sandy Recovery Improvement Act, Public Law 113-2, provides that FEMA will annually adjust the threshold for assistance provided under section 422 (42 U.S.C. § 5189), Simplified Procedures, relating to the Public Assistance program, to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers published by the Department of Labor.

Your cites are 42 U.S.C. § 5189 and 44 CFR § 206.203(c)(1) for large projects and (2) for small projects; FEMA updates the project thresholds by fiscal year <u>here</u>."


