Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill expands the fish and game approvals to which a reduced fee for first-time approvals applies. Under current law, a reduced fee of \$4.25 applies to certain fish and game approvals if issued to a person who has not received that type of approval, or been conferred the privileges of that type of approval, in any of the ten years preceding the date of application. The bill adds to these approvals an annual fishing license issued to a person who is 16 or 17 years old who is a resident of this state or to a resident who is 65 years old or older.
