Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau EMPLOYMENT

Employee records during public health emergency

Under the bill, the requirements that an employer provide an employee's personnel record within seven working days after receiving the request, that the inspection be at a location near the employee's place of employment, and that the inspection be during normal working hours are suspended during a public health emergency.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 103.13 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:
- 5 103.13 (2m) Employee records during an emergency. Notwithstanding s.
- 6 103.13 (2), during the period covered by a state of emergency related to a public

health emergency declared by the governor under s. 323.10, an employer is not required to provide an employee's personnel records within 7 working days after an employee makes a request to inspect his or her personnel records, and an employer is not required to provide the inspection at a location reasonably near the employee's place of employment during normal working hours.
