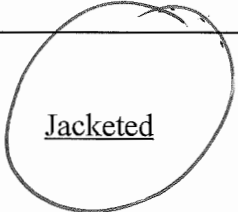
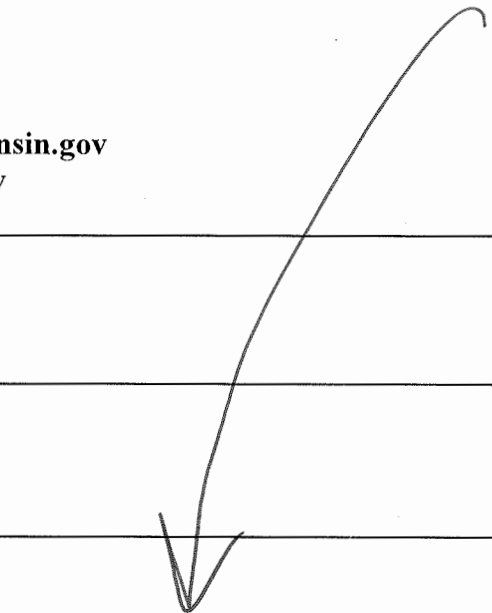

2019 BILL

1 **AN ACT relating to:** authorizing the secretary of administration to transfer
2 employees from any executive branch agency to another executive branch
3 agency during the public health emergency.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Transfer of employees between executive branch agencies

This bill authorizes the secretary of administration to transfer employees from any executive branch agency to another executive branch agency during the public health emergency declared on March 12, 2020, by executive order 72, including any extension. Under the bill, the agency to which an employee is transferred shall pay all salary and fringe benefit costs of that employee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

5 (1) POSITION TRANSFERS.

6 (a) In this subsection:

7 1. "State agency" means any office, commission, board, department, or
8 independent agency in the executive branch of state government.

1 1. "State agency" means any office, commission, board, department, or
2 independent agency in the executive branch of state government.

3 2. "Emergency period" means the period covered by the public health
4 emergency declared on March 12, 2020, by executive order 72, including any
5 extension under s. 323.10.

6 (b) During the emergency period, the secretary of administration may transfer
7 any employee from one state agency to another state agency to provide services for
8 the receiving state agency. The receiving state agency shall pay all salary and fringe
9 benefit costs of the employee during the time he or she is providing services for the
10 receiving state agency. Any action by the secretary under this paragraph shall
11 remain in effect until rescinded by the secretary or 90 days after the public health
12 emergency is terminated, whichever is earliest.

13 (c) If an employee is transferred under par. (b), the receiving agency may not
14 increase the employee's salary at the time of transfer or during the time he or she is
15 providing services for the receiving agency and the transferring agency may not
16 increase the employee's salary at the time the employee returns to the transferring
17 agency.

18 (d) The secretary of administration shall submit a report to the joint committee
19 on finance no later than June 1, 2020, and on the first day of each subsequent month
20 during the emergency period, that provides information on all employee transfers
21 under par. (b). The report shall specify the number of employees transferred, the title
22 of each employee transferred, the title the employee assumed at the receiving agency,
23 and the reasons for each employee transfer.
