Health care provider credential renewals

This bill exempts certain health care provider credentials issued by credentialing boards in the Department of Safety and Professional Services from having to be renewed during the the period covered by the public health emergency declared on March 12, 2020, by executive order 72, and continuing until further specified by the applicable credentialing board (exemption period).

For the next applicable renewal period after the exemption period, the credential holder is not subject to any late renewal fee, and the applicable credentialing board may provide an exemption from or reduction of continuing education or other renewal requirements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

440.08 (5) Renewal suspension for public health emergency. (a) In this subsection, "health care provider credential" means any credential issued under ch. 441, 447, 448, 450, 455, 460, or 462.

- (b) Notwithstanding subs. (1) to (3) and the applicable provisions in chs. 440 to 480, but subject to any professional discipline imposed on the credential, a health care provider credential is not subject to renewal, or any other conditions for renewal including continuing education, and remains valid during the the period covered by the public health emergency declared on March 12, 2020, by executive order 72, including any extension under s. 323.10, and continuing until further specified by the applicable credentialing board.
- (c) A renewal that occurs subsequent to the period described in par. (b) is not subject to the late renewal fee under sub. (3) (a) if the application to renew the credential is received before the next applicable renewal date. Notwithstanding the applicable provisions in chs. 440 to 480, the applicable credentialing board may, for that next applicable renewal date, provide an exemption from or reduction of continuing education or other conditions for renewal.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- (d) A renewal that occurs subsequent to the period described in par. (c) is not subject to the late renewal fee under sub. (3) (a) if the application to renew the credential is received before the next applicable renewal date. Notwithstanding the applicable provisions in chs. 440 to 480, the applicable credentialing board may, for that next applicable renewal date, provide an exemption from or reduction of continuing education or other conditions for renewal.
