Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, under Wisconsin's campaign finance law, a person elected to a state or local government elective office who becomes a candidate for a national, state, or local government office may not use public funds to pay the cost of materials or distribution for 50 or more pieces of substantially identical material during the campaign season. This bill exempts from this prohibition communications relating to a state of emergency or a public health emergency, declared by the governor, made during the emergency period and for 30 days after termination of the emergency.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
