AN ACT relating to: plan to provide support to major industries adversely affected by the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Plan to provide support to major industries

This bill requires the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation to submit a report to the legislature and the governor by June 30, 2020, that includes a plan for providing support to the major industries in Wisconsin that have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 public health emergency, including tourism, manufacturing, agriculture, construction, retail, and services.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) PLANTO ASSIST MAJOR INDUSTRIES. No later than June 30, 2020, the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation shall submit to the legislature in the manner provided under s. 13.172 (2), and to the governor, a report that includes a plan for
