Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides \$5 million/yr. of GPR funding for municipal flood control (MFC) grants, and it requires the Department to allocate at least 20 percent of the funding for projects that involve any of the following:

- 1. Floodproofing and elevation of structures.
- 2. Riparian restoration projects.
- 3. Acquisition of land and easements.
- 4. Construction of structures for flood control and riparian restoration.
- 5. Preparation of flood insurance studies and other flood mapping projects.

Fiscal Effect--State

The additional grant funding provided in the bill would require approximately 447 hours of staff time and \$23,700 over a two-year MFC grant cycle, which translates to annualized amounts of 0.12 FTE and \$11,900, respectively. These costs would be absorbed from within the Department's existing budgetary resources.
