Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill expands the current law requirement for school boards to provide instruction in American Indian studies and specifies, by grade range, when this instruction must be provided. There is a potentially significant fiscal effect at the local level involving:

- increased professional development and resource needs for K-12 teachers to accommodate the expanded instruction requirements compared to current law (1989 Act 31);
- · professional curriculum time for teachers to incorporate information into their courses; and
- cost for potential oversight and reporting of compliance.

The fiscal effect is indeterminate because every school district has different staffing and curricular arrangements.
