Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) and the University of Wisconsin System to jointly administer a program that awards grants to businesses operating in this state for legal, human resources, and staff training expenses related to beginning an internship program.

The fiscal impact is unclear until program guidelines are established for this program.

This internship program would align with the initiative of Focusing on the University Experience from 2020 FWD. The System Level Priority, U2, focuses on providing every UW System student with exposure to at least two high-impact learning practices, which includes internships.
