Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires a person who receives a civil traffic violation related to operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated to appear in person in court to respond to the charge. If the person fails to appear in court, the court is required to enter a default judgment and impose the applicable penalties plus an additional \$300 surcharge.

There is no fiscal impact on the Department of Justice related this this change. The impact on local governments is indeterminate.
