| Description exemption from local zoning ordinances for certain transportation project aggregate and concrete production sites | | | | | |

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 277 would do the following: (a) include aggregate sites and concrete batch sites in the list of temporary road construction-related sites that are exempt, under certain conditions, from local zoning ordinances; (b) define "aggregate site" as a site off of the transportation project property from which aggregate for use in a transportation project is excavated or excavated and processed; and (c) specify that "concrete batch site" means a temporary facility located off of the transportation project property at which ingredients are combined to produce concrete for use in a transportation project. As under current law, the owner of the property would have to consent to the establishment of the site on their property.

The bill would not affect state revenues or appropriations. These provisions could potentially reduce highway project costs associated with transportation of aggregate and concrete materials.
