**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill expands the number of individuals subject to a court order restricting driving privileges to vehicles equipped with ignition interlock devices. Under current law, a court must order ignition interlock restrictions for individuals convicted of second or subsequent offense of operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated (OWI). This bill requires the ignition interlock restriction for all individuals convicted of any OWI offense involving the use of alcohol.

This bill does not have a significant fiscal impact on the Department of Justice. The fiscal impact on location governments is indeterminate.
