Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This fiscal estimate assumes that this legislation does not require law enforcement to collect the information but only for the Department of Transportation to record the information.

The Division of State Patrol currently has a 'Contact Summary' form that is available through the Traffic and Criminal Software (TraCS) application for law enforcement agencies to fill out to collect Traffic Stop information. TraCS is currently used by over 550 Wisconsin law enforcement agencies. That form currently has fields to collect Sex and Race. The form could be updated as a part of a routine update to include Gender and Ethnicity. The Division of State Patrol would anticipate that the update could be released in next release date for updates which would be the Fall pack (October/November). It is unclear whether the Department of Transportation would be tasked with providing the attributes that would be used for the Gender and Ethnicity fields.
