**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill allows minors who are 12 and 13 years of age to provide caddy services without requiring them to be deemed employees of a golf club or employees of a person, partnership, association or corporation, including the state and any municipal corporation or other political subdivision thereof, operating a golf course.

The bill allows the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) to regulate the provision of caddy services by minors. Regulations may include a waiver or modification of permit requirements for caddies.

If enacted, the department anticipates one-time costs to revise the administrative rule pertinent to this bill. In addition, there would be one-time costs for DWD's Equal Rights Division to revise education materials and publications. These costs are absorbable within the agency's operating budget.
