Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

I. Mining Components of the Bill

The bill changes the laws under which the Department of Natural Resources currently regulates mining so that the laws are substantially the same as they existed before enactment of 2013 Wisconsin Act 1 and 2017 Wisconsin Act 134.

Fiscal Effect

The fiscal effects of the proposed changes to the laws regulating metallic mining are directly related to the size and scope of actual projects. Currently, there are no active or proposed metallic mining projects; therefore, any effort to quantify a fiscal effect would be highly speculative and is therefore considered indeterminate at both the state and local level.

II. Forestry Components of the Bill

The bill changes the laws under which the Department of Natural Resources currently administers the Managed Forest Law (MFL) Program so that the laws are substantially the same as they existed before enactment of 2013 Wisconsin Act 81.

The bill would have no fiscal impact to DNR.
