Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill establishes mandatory initial training requirements for guardians. Under the bill, a proposed guardian of the person or the estate must submit, as part of the guardianship case, a sworn and notarized statement to the court that the person has completed the training requirements. The bill requires the Department of Health Services to award a grant to administer and conduct the required guardian training.

This bill has indeterminate fiscal effects for the Department of Children and Families (DCF). If there are situations where a guardian is unable to be appointed because required training has not been completed, then this bill may cause an increase in Child in Need of Protection or Services (CHIPS) cases. This increase in CHIPS cases could increase staff workload at DCF's Division of Milwaukee Child Protective Services as well as other county CPS agencies.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
