Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This fiscal estimate is limited to the provisions of the bill that affect the Department of Revenue.

Under current law, the only subject that most state and municipal employees may collectively bargain is a percentage increase in base wages that does not exceed the percentage increase in the consumer price index. This bill removes that limitation so that state and municipal employees may bargain over any increase in wages. The bill repeals the current law requirement for the department to determine the annual percentage change in the consumer price index at the request of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission.

The bill will result in minimal cost savings for the department.
