Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill amends and creates sections of Wis. Stat. 230 to designate election days as state holidays in which state offices, other than the Elections Commission, would be closed. It would also increase the number of paid holidays for state employees accordingly. Additionally, it requires the University of Wisconsin (UW) System Board of Regents to ensure no classes are held at any UW institution on the day of the spring and general election.

While this bill may increase costs by adding another day to the semester calendars in which there are elections, it would not have a fiscal impact on leave benefits since the UW System is no longer governed by Wis. Stat. 230 for leave benefits.
