Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently, the Groundwater Coordinating Council is attached to the Department of Natural Resources and advises and assists state agencies in the coordination of nonregulatory programs and the exchange of information related to groundwater. The council is made up of several members, including the DNR secretary and the president of the UW System.

The bill would appropriate \$500,000 each to DNR and to the UW System for their respective activities related to the Groundwater Coordinating Council.
