## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases the authorized positions for the Department of Health Services by one full-time position to provide for an advanced epidemiologist dedicated to vector-borne diseases spread by mosquitoes, ticks, and other insects, with a specific emphasis on Lyme disease. The epidemiologist's job duties will include raising awareness and creating informational materials about Lyme disease and other vector-borne diseases.

While the Department currently has some federally funded epidemiological staffing resources for vector-borne disease, these positions are limited by high workload demands. Therefore, the Department would require 1.0 FTE GPR and \$91,400 GPR annually to conduct the activities described in this bill.

In sum, the fiscal effect of the bill equals the amounts appropriated in the bill.
