Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes statutory references to spouses gender neutral, with the intent of aligning Wisconsin statutes with the U.S. Supreme Court ruling in Obergefell v. Hodges. This bill also recognizes legal parentage for same-sex couples under certain circumstances and adopts gender neutral parentage terminology.

At both the state and local levels, staff will need to update literature, websites, etc. to contain gender neutral terminology.

It is assumed that this responsibility will be absorbed within existing departmental and school district resources. Accordingly, this bill has no fiscal impact at the state or local levels.
