ratification of the agreement negotiated between the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System and the Wisconsin State Building Trades Negotiating Committee, for the 2018-19 fiscal year, covering employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an expenditure of funds

## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The agreement negotiated between the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System and the Wisconsin State Building Trades Negotiating Committee assumes a 2.13% increase effective January 6, 2019.

The cost of the increase was estimated using the DOA approved 2016 October Payroll base for Craftworkers as well as the DOA approved variable fringe benefit rate of 15.75%.

The total cost for all funds is estimated to be \$93,879 (\$81,,105 Salary and \$12,774 Fringe). Of this total, the majority of the cost, \$84,952 (\$73,393 Salary and \$11,559 Fringe) is on GPR/Fee funds.

This estimate does not include the University of Wisconsin - Madison Craftworkers. A separate agreement has been negotiated for that institution.
