### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill changes the grounds for finding that a child is in need of protection or services under the Children's Code and for involuntarily terminating parental rights (TPR), eliminates the right to a jury trial in a TPR proceeding, and changes the process for permanency plan reviews under the Children's Code and the Juvenile Justice Code.

The Department anticipates one-time costs to DCF of approximately \$30,000 to update trainings. There may also be increased costs to county child welfare agencies. The extent of these increased costs is indeterminate.
