### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under the bill, a city, village, town, or county may require a presidential or vice-presidential campaign to pay in advance for certain police and sanitation costs. The bill prohibits a political subdivision from issuing a campaign event permit to a presidential or vice-presidential campaign if the political subdivision has evidence that the campaign owes money to another Wisconsin political subdivision for unpaid campaign event costs.

The local fiscal effect is indeterminate. The department does not require local governments to report information on presidential campaign costs.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications
