## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The fiscal impact of this proposal is indeterminate for both the department and local authorities. This bill creates permissive authority for the department, county, city, village, or town to require any person to install empty conduit lines in the state highway right-of-way in certain circumstances. The bill specifies that "any person" may be required to perform the installation. The department assumes that in some instances, such as projects involving connecting highways, local authorities may require the department to install the conduit or the department may require the local authority to install it. In these situations, both the department and local forces would need to hire a contractor to perform the installation, which may have some impact to project costs or timelines. However, it is unknown how often such a situation would arise or whether the installation requirement would be triggered. Therefore, any potential costs are indeterminate.
