2019 Wisconsin Act 64 [2019 Senate Bill 349]

Dispensing of E15 Motor Vehicle Fuel

2019 Wisconsin Act 64 specifies the circumstances under which a retail station may use a dispensing device to dispense various blends of gasoline and ethanol (E10, E15, and gasoline containing no ethanol) through the same fueling nozzle and hose. Under the act, the three varieties of fuel may be dispensed through the same equipment if a label is affixed to the device stating that a minimum purchase of four gallons is required, or if all of the following apply:

- The retail station has at least one other device with a fueling nozzle and hose dedicated to dispensing blends of fuel containing no more than 10 percent ethanol.
- A label is affixed to the single nozzle device stating, “Passenger Vehicles Only. Use in Other Vehicles, Engines and Equipment May Violate Federal Law.”
- The retail station displays signs informing customers of the availability and location of the device dedicated to dispensing fuel containing not more than 10 percent ethanol.

Labels required under the act must satisfy the following requirements:

- The label must be placed on the front or side of the upper half of the dispensing device.
- The label must be conspicuous and legible when viewed from the driver’s seat of a vehicle located within six feet of the dispensing device.
