2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 25

Assembly Bill 25 authorizes a full-time district attorney, deputy district attorney, or assistant district attorney to provide legal services to a person of limited means or to a charitable, religious, civic, community, governmental, or educational organization if the attorney provides the services **without fee or expectation of fee** and the services are not in conflict with the interests of the district attorney's county.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 specifies that for the authorization created by the bill to apply, the legal services must be provided **without fee**, rather than stating that the legal services must be provided without fee or expectation of fee.

BILL HISTORY

Representatives Horlacher and Hebl offered Assembly Amendment 1 on April 5, 2019. On April 11, 2019, the Assembly Committee on Judiciary voted to recommend adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 9; Noes, 0; and voted to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 1.
