2019 SENATE BILL 13

The bill creates an exception to the current requirement that an assessor notify a taxpayer when the taxpayer's property is assessed at a different total than the prior year. Under the bill, an assessor is not required to provide notice of a change in assessment if the assessed land is classified as agricultural land for the current and prior year and the difference between the assessments is \$300 or less.

SENATE AMENDMENT 2

Senate Amendment 2 increases the difference between the assessments to \$500 or less.

BILL HISTORY

On March 26, 2019, Senate Amendment 1 was unanimously recommended for adoption, and Senate Bill 13 was recommended for passage, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 1; by the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Revenue, and Financial Institutions.
