2019 SENATE BILL 29

Senate Bill 29 authorizes a full-time district attorney, deputy district attorney, or assistant district attorney to provide legal services to a person of limited means or to a charitable, religious, civic, community, governmental, or educational organization if the attorney provides the services **without fee or expectation of fee** and the services are not in conflict with the interests of the district attorney's county.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 specifies that for the authorization created by the bill to apply, the legal services must be provided **without fee**, rather than stating that the legal services must be provided without fee or expectation of fee.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Wanggaard offered Senate Amendment 1 to 2019 Senate Bill 29 on April 8, 2019. On September 25, 2019, the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety voted unanimously to recommend adoption of Senate Amendment 1 and passage of the bill, as amended.
