1 **AN ACT to repeal** 103.79 (1); **to renumber and amend** 103.79 (2); and **to amend**
2 103.67 (2) (d) of the statutes; **relating to:** minor golf caddies.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill allows minors who are 12 and 13 years of age to provide caddy services without being employed by a golf course. Current law requires caddies who are 12 and 13 years of age to be employed by a golf course.
