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ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1

January 28, 2021 - Offered by Representatives STEINEKE and Vos.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows: **1.** Page 1, line 4: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with $\mathbf{2}$ page 2, line 2, and substitute: 3 "(1g) PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY DECLARATION. Notwithstanding the expiration 4 5 or termination of a public health emergency by the legislature by joint resolution or 6 by the governor, the governor may issue a subsequent executive order under s. 323.10 7 declaring a public health emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic solely for 8 the purpose of receiving emergency or other allotments under the federal 9 Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Act of 2020; the Families First 10 Coronavirus Response Act of 2020; the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic

1 Security (CARES) Act of 2020; the Paycheck Protection Program and Health Care $\mathbf{2}$ Enhancement Act of 2020; the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021; or any 3 subsequent federal law related to the COVID-19 pandemic enacted before July 1, 4 2022. The governor may issue this executive order only if the receipt of the $\mathbf{5}$ allotments requires an active state-declared emergency or disaster. The governor 6 may not exercise any other emergency powers during a public health emergency declared under this subsection, including powers specified under s. 323.12 (4), except 7 8 that the governor may order into state active duty members of the national guard 9 under s. 321.39 and may approve plans developed by the adjutant general under s. 10 323.13.".".
