# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. of the statutes is amended to read:
4	23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. A weight, without fluids, of 2,000 3,000 pounds or less.
5	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. of the statutes is amended to read:
6	23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. It does not meet federal motor vehicle safety standards in
7	effect on July 1, 2012; is not a golf cart, low-speed vehicle, dune buggy, mini-truck,
8	or tracked vehicle; is designed to be used primarily off of a highway; and has, and was
9	originally manufactured with, a weight, without fluids, of not more than 2000 3,000
10	pounds.

## 2021 WISCONSIN ACT 70

AN ACT to amend 23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. and 23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. of the statutes; relating to: the weight limit for utility terrain vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. of the statutes is amended to read:

23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. A weight, without fluids, of  $\frac{2,000}{3,000}$  pounds or less.

**SECTION 2.** 23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. of the statutes is amended to read:

23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. It does not meet federal motor vehicle safety standards in effect on July 1, 2012; is not a golf cart, low-speed vehicle, dune buggy, mini-truck, or tracked vehicle; is designed to be used primarily off of a highway; and has, and was originally manufactured with, a weight, without fluids, of not more than  $\frac{2000}{3,000}$  pounds.
