1 AN ACT *to renumber and amend* 347.26 (7); and *to create* 347.26 (7) (c) of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** warning lights on highway vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 347.26 (7) of the statutes is renumbered 347.26 (7) (intro.) and
4 amended to read:

5 347.26 (7) WARNING LAMPS ON CERTAIN HIGHWAY VEHICLES. (intro.) Any vehicle
6 of the department or a county or municipal highway department ~~which~~ that by
7 reason of its use upon a highway creates a vehicular traffic hazard requiring the
8 exercise of unusual care in approaching, overtaking, or passing may be equipped
9 with ~~a~~ any of the following configurations of flashing red or, amber lamp, or green
10 lamps:

11 (a) A lamp of the dome-light type or with 2 flashing red or amber,
