Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB-1055 requires the Technical College System Board to make grants to technical college district boards in areas with nurse aide shortages to expand access to nurse aide training.

The legislation provides \$500,000 in FY2021-22 and \$500,000 in FY2022-23 for the grants and creates a new appropriation specifically for this purpose.
