Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill prohibits the sale and use of coal tar-based sealant products and high PAH sealant products (products with more than 0.1 percent polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons by weight). The ban on selling goes into effect approximately six months after the effective date of the bill; the ban on the use of the products goes into effect approximately 12 months after the effective date of the bill.

Fiscal Effect

The bill would reduce state and local costs by an indeterminate amount because the prohibition on the sale and use of coal-tar based and PAH sealant products would reduce work efforts needed to combat the impacts that those products have on water quality, aquatic life, remediation projects, etc.
