### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law provides that only certain criminal proceedings may be conducted by telephone or live audiovisual means unless good cause to the contrary is shown, and that any action taken by the court or any party in such a proceeding has the same effect as if made in open court. This bill specifies that any criminal proceeding or any hearing on a motion for an extension of time for a trial involving an interstate detainer may be conducted by telephone or live audiovisual means, unless good cause to the contrary is shown, and that any action taken by the court or any party in such a proceeding has the same effect as if made in open court.

Fiscal Effect – Costs/Savings: The Director of State Courts has determined that this bill has no fiscal impact on the Courts. The bill will allow for more efficient court proceedings and scheduling for circuit courts.
